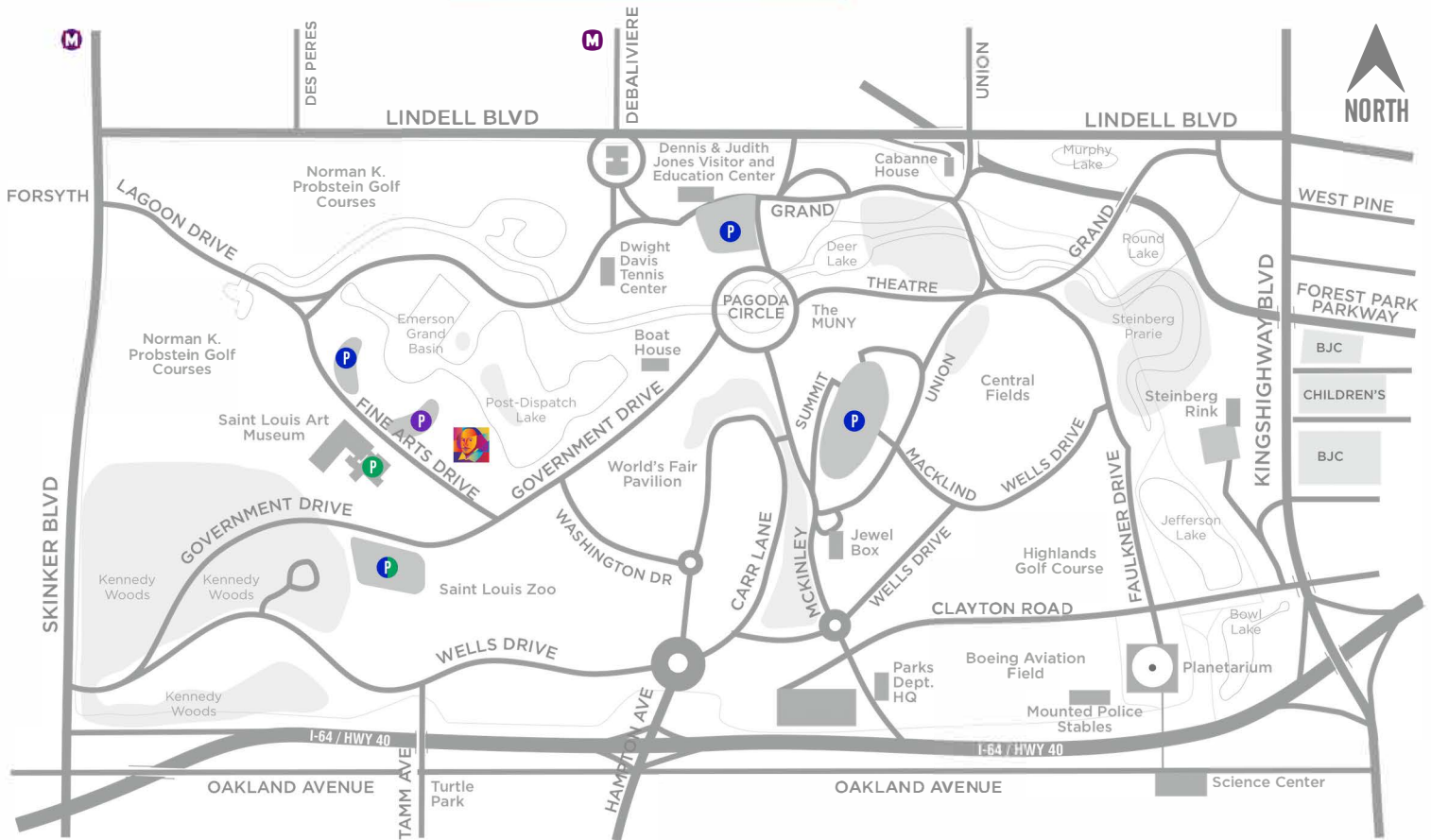


FOREST PARK - SAINT LOUIS



LOCATION

Shakespeare Glen is located in Forest Park, just off Fine Arts Drive on the east side of Art Hill between the Saint Louis Zoo and the Saint Louis Art Museum.

GETTING HERE

There are nine entrances to Forest Park, including Hampton & Wells, Tamm Avenue bridge, Skinker & Wells, Skinker & Forsyth, Lindell at DeBaliviere, Lindell at Forest Park Parkway, Lindell at West Pine, Kingshighway at West Pine, Kingshighway at Oakland to Tamm. **Be aware that traffic frequently backs up at the Hampton entrance to the Park.**

BICYCLE

There are bicycle paths located throughout Forest Park. Bike racks can be found near the Festival Lobby and in front of the Art Museum. **Please dismount your bike when in Shakespeare Glen.**

PARKING

As parking is in high demand during the Festival, we suggest arriving early. Please note that The Munny and Festival performances will overlap beginning June 13. This will impact parking east of the Hampton Ave entrance.

P FREE PARKING:

- West Circle Drive Lot, west of the Saint Louis Art Museum. 4 min. walk
- Saint Louis Zoo lot on Government Dr., after the Zoo has closed. 8 min. walk
- Lots by the Munny and in front of the Forest Park Visitor's Center. 20 min. walk
- Free street parking is available throughout Forest Park.

P RESERVED PARKING:

- Members at the Thespian Society level and above are entitled to reserve parking spots in the East Circle Drive lot, east of the Saint Louis Art Museum. 2 min. walk

P PAID PARKING:

- The Saint Louis Art Museum's underground Parking Garage. 2 min. walk
- Saint Louis Zoo lot on Government Dr., before 6 PM. 8 min. walk

Accessible parking is available in both the West and East Circle Drive Lots and in the Saint Louis Art Museum's underground Parking Garage. Drop-off areas are located on Fine Arts Drive directly in front of the Art Museum. Be sure to lock your vehicle and keep valuables out of sight.

METRO / TROLLEY

METROLINK: 25 min. walk — Forest Park DeBaliviere Station

The Forest Park DeBaliviere Station is the closest MetroLink stop to the Festival from either the Blue or the Red line.

FOREST PARK TROLLEY: 2 min. walk — Saint Louis Art Museum stop

The Forest Park Trolley stops a short distance from Shakespeare Glen, and is \$2 for adults and \$1 for children and seniors. A valid Metro Reduced Fare Permit is required for the Senior and Disabled discount. Kids four and under ride free. The Trolley runs from 9 AM to 7 PM. **Be aware that Trolley service stops before the performance ends.**
